Terms and conditions

1. There is no entry fee but the competition is only open to Kent Gun Club members who joined by 31 December 2011 and have paid a full years membership and continue to be a fully paid member for the entire duration of the competition.
 2. Ken Newman & Bob Barrett are not eligible to compete.
 3. Only scores from CPSA Registered shoots run by Kent Gun Club shall be eligible for submission into the total.
 4. Of the Registered shoots in the competition Period (below) the highest 20 scores may be submitted only after the date your membership fee has been paid, – There will be approximately 36 registered shoots in the competition period. A lesser number may be submitted but no more than 20.
 5. The competition period shall run from 10 September 2011 to 9 September 2012 inclusive and shall include any registered events held on those dates.
 6. The Prize winner will be announced at the end of the shoot on 9 September 2012 and be displayed at Barretts of Caterham and published in the club newsletter “Line Ready”.
 7. The prize shall only be awarded in accordance with firearms legislation to a full shotgun certificate holder. And is not transferable.
 8. No alternative prizes or cash equivalents will be offered.
 9. The winner will be the highest points scored
 - 9.1 In the event of a tie, a shoot off over 25 birds DTL will be undertaken – CPSA rules to apply
 - 9.2 In the event of a tie still existing after a 25-bird shoot-off, a sudden death shoot-off will take place – normal DTL rules to apply.
- In the event of any dispute a jury of Kent Gun Club Officers and officials (such members to be determined at the sole discretion of Mr Bob Barrett) shall adjudicate, their decision shall be final.
10. Kent Gun Club reserves the right to amend or alter these terms subject to 30-days’ notice published in LINE READY and or displayed at Barretts of Caterham and in the club house at Kent Gun Club.
 11. Scores will be counted as per full Rules of the CPSA
 12. It is your responsibility to keep your own records. The registered scores sent to the CPSA from Kent Gun Club registered events will be final. A score card will be provided to each club member for them to keep their own record of scores.

Example **Fabarm 20**

You shoot 28 Registered events run by Kent Gun Club between the competition period of 10 September 2011 and 9 September 2012. You can submit your best 20 scores towards the competition.

If you only shoot 18 Registered events you can submit only 18 scores

If you shoot 36 events you can still only submit the best 20
